## What will I be studying?

- A range of texts and tasks enabling students to develop creative writing skills, structure writing effectively and improve grammatical accuracy
- A range of different texts to read and analyse, covering different time periods, including
  - Non-fiction texts from the 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> centuries
  - Literary fiction texts from the 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> centuries

### What skills will I develop?

- Your ability to read and understand a range of texts, particularly unseen fiction and non-fiction
- Your ability to analyse the use of language, use technical vocabulary accurately and recognise different writers' viewpoints
- Your ability to analyse language, structure and writers' intentions critically
- Your ability to produce creative texts for a range of genres, purposes and audiences
- Your written communication skills and grammatical accuracy

#### How will the course be structured?

Examination preparation and development of skills throughout Years 10 and 11

#### How will I be assessed?

External examination - 100%

Paper 1: 50% – 1 hour 45 minutes

Paper 2: 50% – 1 hour 45 minutes

Equally weighted for reading and writing skills

#### Spoken Language

Students will also get an additional accreditation for speaking and listening activities completed in class. Candidates will be assessed on their ability to present using Standard English
