What will I be studying?

Students will also become digitally literate – able to use, express themselves and develop their ideas through, information and communication technology – at a level suitable for the future workplace and as active participants in a digital world

- How changes in technology affect safety, including new ways to protect their online privacy and identity, and how to identify and report a range of concerns
