What will I be studying?

Students will learn vocabulary and phrases that are most commonly used in the foreign language. Students will practice applying these key pieces of vocabulary in real-life scenarios, in order to practise their delivery.

Students will learn how to adapt vocabulary and grammar in a range of purposeful contexts, to maximise their ability to express themselves, facts and ideas.

As a result, students will be confident in producing language to express the key messages that are most commonplace and useful when communicating in a foreign language.

What skills will I develop?

The course offers students the opportunity to develop their language skills and knowledge, regardless of their experience and level on entering the course.

Students will be assessed on the following:

- Speaking
- Writing

Students will develop the following skills:

- Identify key points and details in conversation.
- Use and adapt set phrases to express ideas.
- Use and adapt questions to clarify details.

How will the course be structured?

The course will be taught over the two years, with two hours of contact per week.

Students will study the following units, focussing on the development of both their writing and speaking skills:

- Communicating personal information
- Education and employment
- Social activities

How will I be assessed?

Students will produce two pieces of work per unit that will be assessed. One of the pieces of work will be a written piece, such as a letter. The other piece of work will be spoken, such as a presentation or a dialogue.

The work will be assessed by the teacher throughout the course. At the end of the course, all work will be moderated by the exam board.
