What will I be studying?

Through a series of extended case studies, students will explore ethical, philosophical and religious responses to the following:

- 1. Religion & relationships
- 2. Women in religion
- 3. Standing up to hate
- 4. Religious attitudes to poverty
- 5. Suffering and Evil

What skills will I develop?

- An enquiring approach to the study of religion and human experience
- An understanding of how to put key concepts into religious and secular contexts.
- An ability to communicate, reflect on and evaluate values, opinions and attitudes to key issues.
- The ability to apply beliefs and values (secular & religious) to real life situations.

How will the course be structured?

The course will be delivered within a carousel system, alongside IT and CCW

Year 10

- Religion & Relationships
- Women in religion

Year 11

- Standing up to hate
- Religious attitudes to poverty

How will I be assessed?

The course will be assessed internally, using existing Key Stage 4 criteria – with an emphasis on evaluative responses (AO2)
