I am writing to inform you of a new series of homework clubs that will be starting on Monday 23 September with the aim of supporting your child. The sessions will take place after school each day in the library from 3:30pm until 4:15pm.

To support this, the school has set up various homework support sessions that we are inviting your child to attend. The sessions will be supervised by staff and Sixth Form students who have excelled at GCSE and continue to excel with their A level studies and are able to offer their subject expertise. The Sixth Form students will act as a guide but also as a positive role model to instill positive working habits with your child to ensure they succeed at Drayton Manor.

Completing homework, as well as attending school at least 96% of the time, is proven to be critical in not only achieving excellent exam results in the future, but just as importantly, in ensuring that students are able to access the world beyond school and to be successful.

Students will be able to drop in to any session during the week in the library, but they must require parental permission to do so. Please complete the slip at the end of this letter and return to your child's tutor. Alternatively, please ask them to collect a letter from student reception that you can sign and then return to school.
