



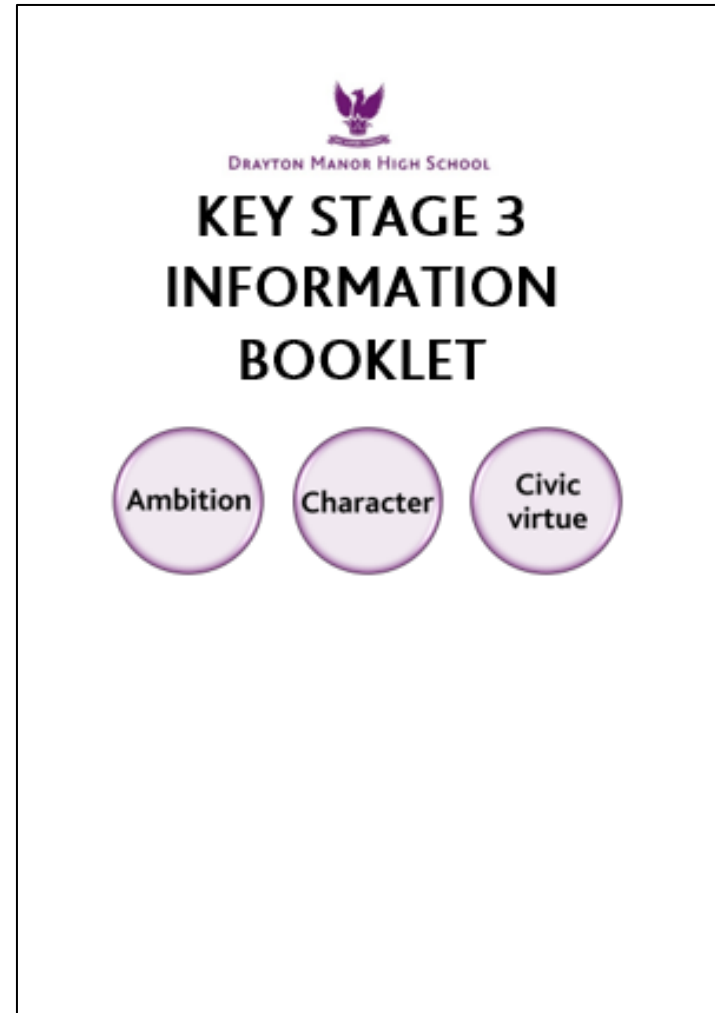

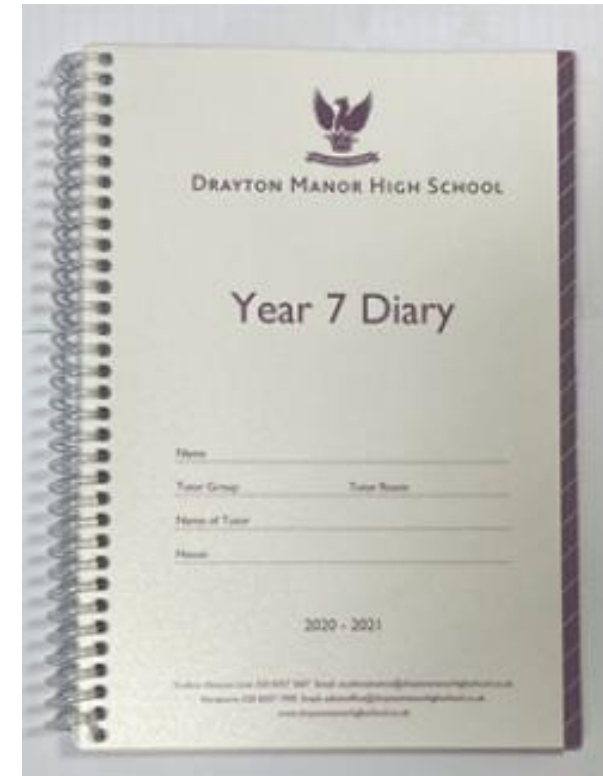

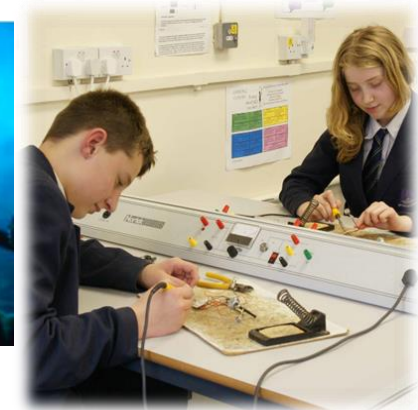

Reporting your Child's Progress

- Parent's evening 1 May 2025
- Termly reports sent home via email
- ATL (Attitude to Learning) 1-4 and subject progress

Punctuality

- Pupils must be in their form rooms, sat down and ready to learn, by 8:55am.
- Therefore it is important that they are in school at least 10 minutes before this to ensure punctuality.
- If a student is on-site but not in their tutor room by 8.55, they will be marked as late.
- Lateness to school will result in a 45-minute detention.

School uniform

Tutors will be monitoring that

- Students' uniform is correct
- Extremes of fashion for clothes, hair, make-up, jewellery are not permitted
- No student is wearing make-up and/or nail varnish
- Students are allowed to wear one pair of stud earrings only in the ear lobe, these must be plain silver or gold. No other piercings are allowed
- Outdoor coats must be plain blue or black, no logos, fur, coloured lining or bright zips
- If students' uniform is not correct and they do not have a note with a valid reason, they will be taken to medical and offered an alternative uniform, if this is not available then the student will remain 1:1 with their Head of Year

If students forget their kit

- Students will be provided with kit from the PE department at the beginning of the lesson. If students repeatedly fail to bring their kit they will be sanctioned with a department detention
- If they know they will not have their kit for any reason they **MUST** provide a note and bring along suitable, alternative clothing so they can participate in the lesson

Are lessons at the School field or on-site?

- PE lessons are always in School
- Games lessons take place both at the School field on Greenford Avenue or at school
- Students have been informed of the location of their lesson
- Students make their way to the field with their class teacher

PE / Games

→ Valuables

Staff can only accept responsibility for those valuables handed to the teacher at the start of the lesson. Anything left in blazers or bags is the students' responsibility

→ Away Matches

Letters will be sent home or notes will be written in the back of the diary for you to sign

→ Home Matches

Notes will be written in the diary or slips given for your information

→ Labelling Kit

All kit must be labelled to avoid anything going missing



Preparation for the school day

- Encourage students to get into the routine of packing their school bag each evening, making sure they have packed the necessary equipment and books for the day ahead.
- Remind students to use Show My Homework to ensure they have completed any homework that is due in for the next day. You are also able to access their homework using the website so can help students in reminding them about homework they have due in.
- Use the school diary as a place to communicate with subject teachers they have the next day.
